

Handling Precautions for Knobs (K)

To ensure safe use, be sure to read these precautions together with the general precautions.

Precautions for Use

- Use a compatible shaft for the knob.
- When fixing a knob to a shaft, use a tightening tool suitable for the set screw size, hexagonal hole size, and screw head.
- Note that fixing a screwed type product to a shaft using excessively high tightening torque may lead to damage or chipping of the mold.
- Note that fixing a collet chuck type product to a shaft using excessively high torque may lead to damage of the screw thread.
- Indication points and lines on knobs are painted or printed. Do not use chemicals (including detergent), or the indication marks may peel off, undergo discoloration, or disappear.
- Be careful not to drop or scrape products. Doing so may lead to chipping, scratches and deformation.
- The indication point or line is on the position 180 degree from the set screw. If accuracy is required, consult with us separately.
(When a product uses two set screws, the position is not 180 degree from the screws)
